



# ELEMENTAL ART: A CONTEST (Extended deadline!)

To celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Periodic Table, The Division of the History of Chemistry (HIST) announces a contest **OPEN TO ALL** for **ORIGINAL ART** in one of the following categories with themes related to the chemical elements, their discovery, or uses:

1. Poem
2. Cartoon
3. Photograph

The **three best works** in each category (selected by a professional panel of judges) will receive certificates, monetary awards (\$250, \$200, or \$150 for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, respectively), and will be published in the HIST Newsletter and Website. Depending on the number of submissions, a volume with the works may be published as well.
