

The Citation for Chemical Breakthrough Award plaque is the entrance to the archives department of the Académie des sciences, a place known and frequented by all the enthusiasts of the history of science.

On the wall opposite to the CCB Award plaque is the ACS Chemical Landmarks plaque dedicated in 1999 honoring Antoine-Laurent Lavoisier who "forever changed the practice and concepts of chemistry by forging a new series of laboratory analyses that would bring order to the chaotic centuries of Greek Philosophy and medieval alchemy."
